

## From the Quarterdeck

Fishing Bay Yacht Club is on the cusp of reaching the peak of a very high mountain. We are approaching the successful completion of our New Building Project and our Fund Raising Campaign. Our entire membership should be proud of what we have done. The building is coming along nicely, members who have seen it say, "it is great!" When you tell someone - "I look forward to next year at FBYC" - they respond - "you know, the new building is going to be really fun."

If you were at the Annual Awards Dinner at CCV, you would have seen the impressive poster showing the donors to our campaign and heard the report from Commodore Bev Crump that we have raised almost \$350,000 of which \$156,000 cash has been received. An updated list of names of donors, reflecting a few gifts received in the last month, is located elsewhere in this issue of the Log. We are circulating the list for several reasons.

First and foremost - **thank you all for supporting this campaign and making it possible to complete this large project without a member assessment.**

That is a marvelous accomplishment.

The list of donors - in some form - with each donor's name - will be displayed permanently in the new Clubhouse. We want the list to accurately reflect each donor's wishes. Names may be inadvertently omitted or misspelled. The current list shows 183 pledges and/or gifts, broken down by giving level, as follows:

November 13, 2001- Wachovia Bank

Both 2001 and 2002 Board members were in attendance.

### **REAR COMMODORE - DAVID HAZLEHURST**

**SECRETARY - Lud Kimbrough** (reported by David Hazlehurst) – The next membership meeting will be held on December 10 at 6:30 p.m. at Elizabeth Staas' home.

**TREASURER - Mason Chapman** – Mason explained the format of the financial report for the benefit of the new Board members.

**LOG STREAMER - Tom Roberts** (reported by David Hazlehurst) – Members were reminded that articles for the Log should be forwarded to Randy Alley by the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month. Randy and Tom will work together on preparing the December Log.

**DOCKS - Debbie Cycotte** – Debbie has the permits for the floating dock and dinghy hoist. The dinghies that have been enrolled are being identified and tagged. One small slip is available.

**GROUNDS - Bob Kates** (reported by David Hazlehurst) – Dec. 1 will be a Clean-up Day held at the club.

**WINTER PROGRAM - John Koedel III** (reported by Alain Vincey) – Alain has made several telephone calls about possible winter programs. He is also planning to hold some mini-seminars and suggested that the one design fleets make plans to get together during the winter.

**FINANCE - Strother Scott** – The 2002 budget and the dues/fees schedule were approved at the October Board meeting. Bev Crump, Fundraising Chairman, reported that a few new pledges have been received.

**NEW BUILDING - Judy Buis** – The windows are in, the roof has been shingled, and some siding is up. The plumbing has been roughed in and electrical work is scheduled to begin. Outside work should be finished before we have bad weather.

**LONG RANGE - Waddy Garrett** – PHRF of Chesapeake has contacted Waddy for information on Fred Wil-

liams. Fred, now deceased, was a member of FBYC for many years and instrumental in bringing PHRF to this area. PHRF plans a tribute for Fred in the form of a plaque which will be presented to the club when we have the dedication of the new building. Waddy, Bob Kates and David Hazlehurst have been working on a plan to ease the club's parking problem, and Waddy presented their proposal for increasing the number of parking spots on the Jackson Creek side. A motion was passed to authorize Grounds to proceed with the addition of approximately 16 parking spaces as agreed upon with Rear Commodore David Hazlehurst, who will coordinate with Bob Kates.

**CRUISING DIV. CDR. - Sam Stoakley** – Sam proposed February 15 as the date for the Bermuda High Party. He needs volunteers and input on possible locations. He would also welcome some ideas for cruising destinations in 2002.

Randy Alley has advised Jan Monnier that West Marine may be interested in holding one of their West Marine Fun Regattas at FBYC next summer. This is a 2-day event for Junior members.

Randy moved that the club accept the West Marine offer to sponsor a Fun Day Regatta at FBYC in 2002; second by Mike Karn; motion passed.

There will be a meeting at Waddy Garrett's on November 28 to discuss the Junior program and its purposes. A report will be presented to the Board for approval.

## **Dinghy storage**



## **Late Fall/Winter Facilities Plan**


